PROCESS

SHORT CUT TO FAST RESULTS

- 1. Start with the 2 primary scale shape positions (1 & 4)
 - 2. Set aside a specific period of time for each position
 - 3. Master all tools in 1 position before moving on
 - **4.** Stay in the key of C-Major / A-Minor

LONG TERM PROCESS

- 1. Learn the diatonic scale shapes and tie them together
- 2. Learn the **pentatonic scale shapes** & tie them together
 - 3. Learn the arpeggio shapes and tie them together
- **3.** Integrate the three elements (See Short cut to fast results)
